

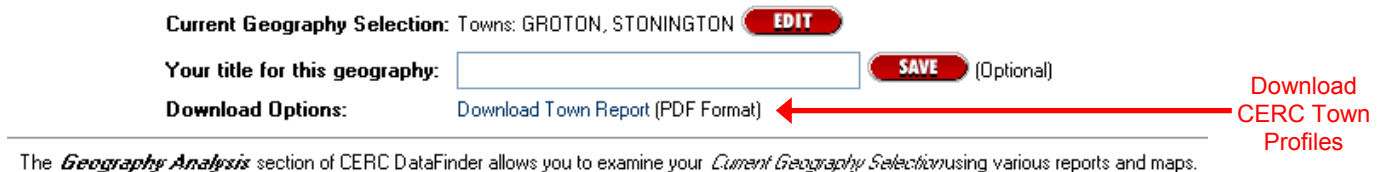
Connecticut Town Updates in CERC DataFinder®

Many of the variables that comprise the CERC reports have recently been updated. Two of the reports in particular have significant updates: "CERC Establishment" and "CERC Housing."

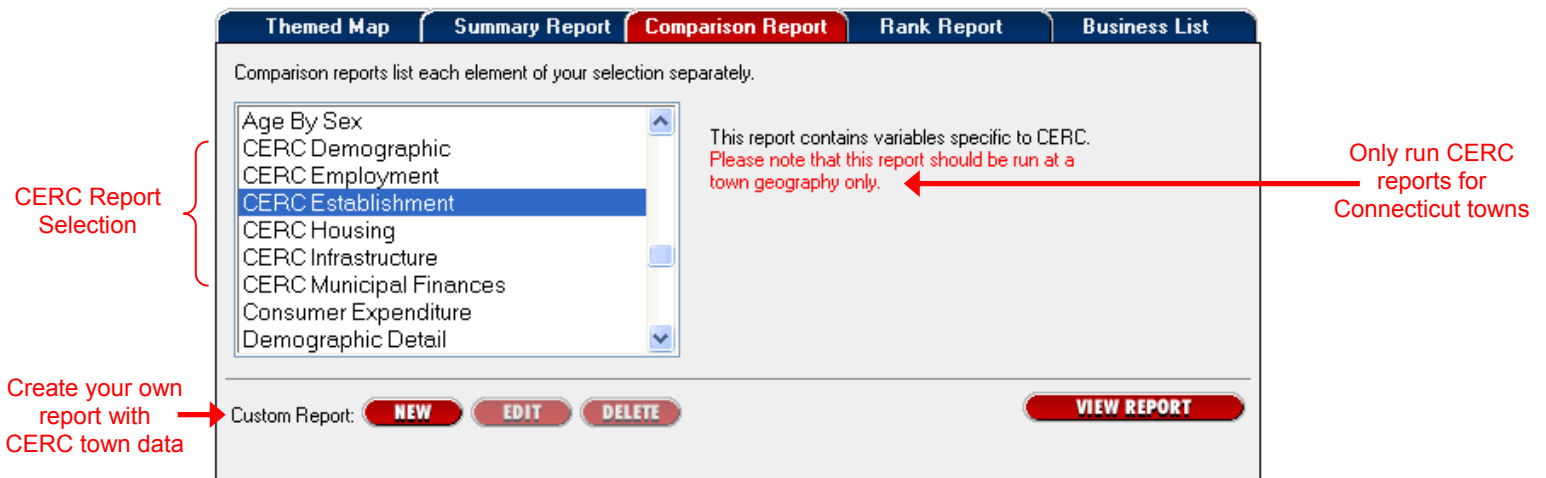
- "CERC Establishment" now provides 2005 business counts by industry sector for every town.
- "CERC Housing" has a few updates, most notably 2002 housing stock, 2004 median house sales and 2004 house sales by price range for every town.

Remember, any summary or comparison report named "CERC" should only be created using Connecticut town geographies. You can also create your own custom report using a variety of CERC data by clicking "New" next to "Custom Report." Updated data in this section include estimated 2005 employment and sales by industry and town.

CERC Town Profiles can also be downloaded directly from DataFinder: just click on "Download Town Report" once you have chosen Connecticut towns as your current geography selection.
