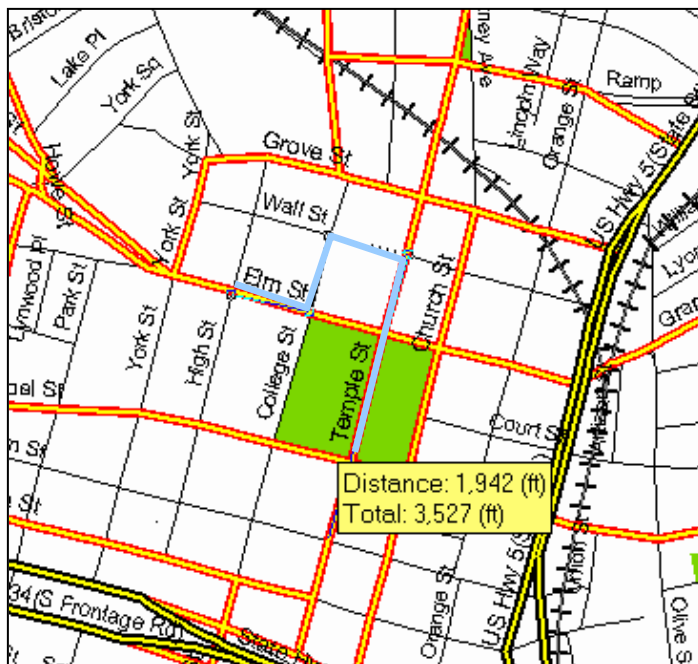
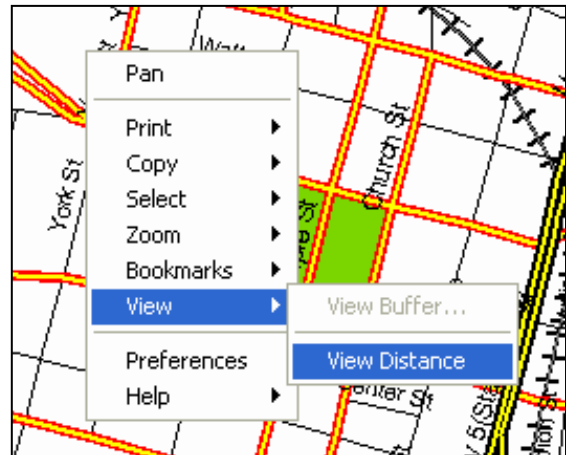


Viewing Distances on CERC DataFinder™ Maps

From time to time, you may find it useful to calculate the length of a road on a map. To have DataFinder calculate the distance for you, right-click with the mouse, select "View" and then "View Distance." Your mouse arrow will then have a symbol next to it that looks like: ►◄.

To begin calculating the distance, move your mouse to the starting point on the map and left-click once. You can see the starting point on the map below is at the corner of High and Elm Streets. If you want to change the direction of the distance calculation at an intersection, just left-click once. A yellow box shows "Distance" (the length since your last left-click) and the "Total" (the total length since the beginning of the calculation). To end using this tool, simply double-click.
