

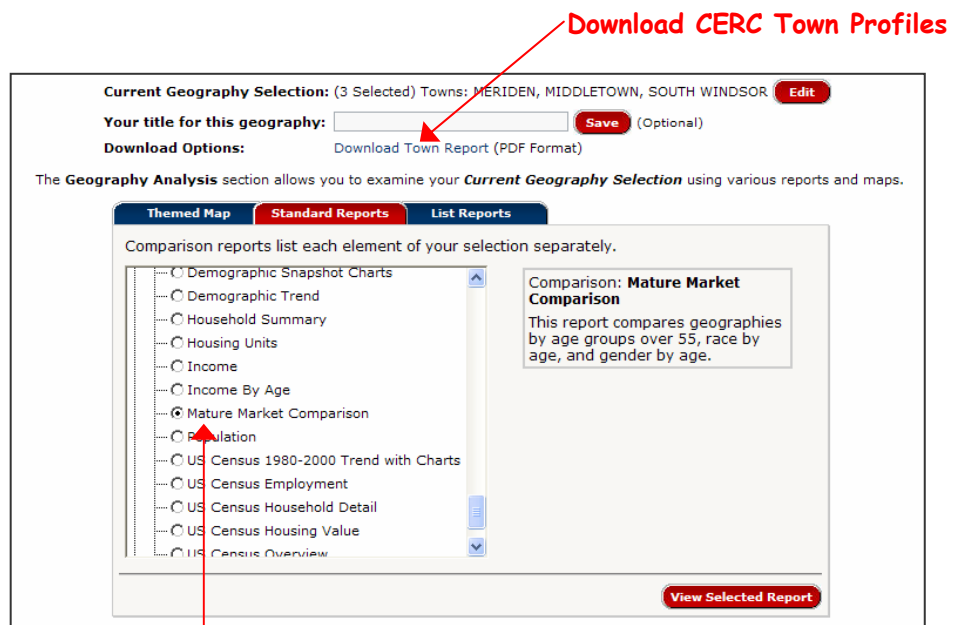


### Town Profiles Updated in DataFinder

A popular CERC product is the Town Profiles, which are two-page pdf reports of demographic and economic information for every municipality in the state. They are updated as new data becomes available. You can access the Town Profiles directly from CERC's web site (<http://www.cerc.com/townprofiles.html>) or through CERC DataFinder®. To access the reports in DataFinder, choose a town or group of towns as your geography selection. Above the report selections, there will be an option to download a town report as seen in the figure. From there you can access the Town Profiles.

### Analyzing Older Populations

News reports about about baby boomers retiring. Many analysts need data on this age group to observe trends and make recommendations that affect all aspects of the economy. The 'Mature Market Comparison' is a new report that looks at population by gender, income and race for age groups over 55 years. The report includes data estimates for the current year, which for now is 2007.
